Call for papers

Call: The Institute of Library and Information Research of the Universidad Nacional Autónoma de Mexico (UNAM) and the FOTODOC Group of the Universidad Complutense de Madrid, convene the III INTERNATIONAL PHOTOGRAPHIC DOCUMENTATION CONGRESS that will be held in Ciudad Universitaria, Mexico City, from the 6th to 9th of March 2018.

Objective: To promote the meeting between researchers and professionals interested in photography as a document in all its aspects (art, heritage, information, applications, teaching or technology) in order to analyze the state of the issue from different perspectives and to contribute in the research by presenting papers and communications on various topics.

Topics: The Congress will address the following topics: Recovery, preservation, conservation, treatment and dissemination of photographic collections in public and private institutions, uses and applications of photography (press, advertising, art, publishing, culture, web portals, etc.), as well as teaching and research projects in general. However, they may be considered works that deal with other topics related to the study of photography as a document.

Presentation of the works (Communications)

The submission of abstracts of proposals for this call must be made no later than 6:00 p.m. of January 26th, 2017 to the e-mail address: diana@iibi.unam.mx attending to the following conditions:

1.) A summary of the work (maximum 500 words) containing: title, name of the author or authors and their institutional affiliation, the summary itself with purpose, content, results (if any) and bibliography in Chicago's style

2.) Author's curricular profile

Both documents must be in Word format. The used font must be Arial 11, the space between lines 1.5 and double space between paragraphs; the margins of the pages of 3 cm. per side.

The authors of the selected abstracts will be individually notified since February 19th, 2018.
